Hoover Presidential Foundation announces trip to FDR and JFK Presidential Libraries

WEST BRANCH, IOWA – May 21, 2015 – The Hoover Presidential Foundation is pleased to offer a five-night tour package to the East Coast to visit two renowned Presidential Libraries. On this year's Annual Members Trip, individuals will visit the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum in Hyde Park, NY and the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum in Boston, Mass. The trip will be Friday, August 28 through Wednesday, September 2.

"This year's trip marks some firsts for current Foundation staff," said Delene McConnaha, Foundation membership and academic programs manager and trip coordinator. "It will be our first time flying and will also be our first time visiting Democratic Presidential Libraries."

In addition to the FDR Presidential Library and JFK Presidential Library visits, other trip highlights include a guided tour of Boston's iconic sites, a stop in New York City's Times Square, a visit to the Vanderbilt Mansion and Eleanor Roosevelt's home, and dinner at the Culinary Institute of America.

This is the third annual member trip for the current Foundation staff. Past trips have included visits to the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum in Springfield, Ill., Harry S. Truman Presidential Library and Museum in Independence, MO, and Dwight D. Eisenhower Presidential Library and Museum in Abilene, KS.

Anyone interested in the trip is encouraged to act quickly. "Seats are going fast," said McConnaha, who has planned and attended the two previous trips. "Those trips were a lot of fun, and I anticipate this year's trip to be no different."
