Additional Information:

- Applicants are responsible for making all transportation and destination arrangements through the Hoover Presidential Library and Museum and/or the Hoover National Historic Site.
- The grant does not cover other related costs including any admission fees.
- Schools may receive only one grant between August 1 and June 30 of each school year.
- To be eligible to apply, the school must be a non-profit and tax-exempt public, private, home or charter school that provides daily education to K-12 grade students.
- Schools with a Title I status or high reduced lunch percentage will be given priority.
- The formula used to determine the grant amount is \$3.00/mile per bus.
- The Bus Grant is used solely to visit the Herbert Hoover campus.
- The school will receive funds for the grant only when the Hoover Presidential Foundation receives the Request for Reimbursement form within the same fiscal year as the visit. It is requested that some digital form of Thank You be submitted to the Hoover Presidential Foundation for marketing purposes along with the Request for Reimbursement form.
- After the trip, teachers are encouraged to send student letters, drawings, digital photos and poems about their experience to the Hoover Presidential Foundation. These help us tell the story of the School Bus Grant program and keep the donations rolling.
